Exemptions: Include all kindergarten students with a medical or religious exemption on file. Students must have a valid exemption on file that states the child’s name, DOB, and the vaccines to be exempted. Medical Exemptions require completion of either form DHHS 3987 or DHHS 3995 and must be signed by an NC licensed physician.

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Immunization Status Definitions

- **Up to Date** includes students who have received the required number of doses. Students with documentation of proof of immunity to measles, mumps, rubella, and/or varicella should be counted as “Up to Date”
- **Medical and religious exemptions** include students with both exemptions to all vaccines, and vaccine specific exemptions.
- **Provisionally Enrolled** - MUST be on a physician approved catch-up schedule. Previously called “in-process,” this status includes children who have had at least one in a series of immunizations but cannot complete the series due to minimum dose intervals. To maintain provisional enrollment status, they must complete the series at minimum dose intervals. While these children are considered legally compliant, they should still be reported as “Not Up to Date” in question 3d.
- **Incomplete Record / No Record** - includes students who have submitted a certificate of immunization but have not received all the required immunizations for kindergarten attendance. This includes students who are missing all doses of a required vaccine, and those who have partially completed the series and are eligible to receive their next dose. Also includes students who are “Not Up to Date” Because they have not submitted a certificate of immunization
