

Library Map of the World SDG Stories

When a story submission is received or a potential story is identified, the LMW team curates the story closely with the contributor. Here is what happens at each step.

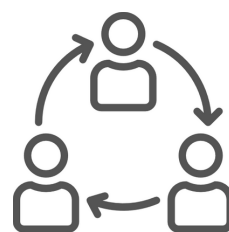
Curation Process

SDGs / Narrative

Curator together with Contributor drafts narrative text emphasizing impact. LMW team checks the relevance of selected SDGs. Title and further links added. English proofreading completed.

Pictures / Videos

LMW team selects and edits photos and videos. Contributor prepares metadata for pictures and videos. Copyright licences are checked.

STEP

03

Release [English]

After we finalise the relevant SDGs, narrative and further information links, and visual material, the English version of SDG story is published on the LMW website.



STEP

04

Translation [Optional]

Contributor decides on having a translation of the story in local language. If yes, LMW team prepares translation template and Contributor translates the title, narrative, titles of further information links and visuals metadata in the selected language. LMW team adds translation to the LMW website.



Communications

Done! Time to share! IFLA team prepares a short video about SDG story and posts on social networks. It's ready to share and use. Contributor shares on own networks
