

## ADDENDUM A

### ADHA Position Descriptions

#### The Committee on Policy & Bylaws

- The Committee on Policy & Bylaws consists of 4 members, the speaker of the house and a board advisor. The committee is responsible for the following:
  - Review of the ADHA Policy Manual and the ADHA Bylaws
  - Review of the Standing Rules and Procedures of the House of Delegates
  - Review of proposed resolutions and proposed bylaws amendments
  - The chair of the committee is responsible for reviewing submissions for Candidate's Corner

#### Leadership Development Committee

- The Leadership Development Committee will mentor and develop individuals interested in future leadership roles, build strategies to foster leadership and service opportunities, and review and recommend necessary leader skillsets to the BOT. LDC will be content advisors for implementation of UYP and maintain engagement of past participants. (BOT-18-17/BOT-7-13/BOT 19-08)
- The Leadership Development Committee will be composed of the immediate past president, one past board member, and two additional members to be appointed by the president. The vice president will serve as board advisor.

#### The Committee on Annual Conference

- The Committee on Annual Conference will consist of two to four members from the host city who are involved in the local community and the trustee whose district the event is being hosted who will act as board advisor. (BOT-25-07)
- Responsible for the planning and implementation of the Community Service Day through identifying the facility/activity, working with the chosen facility on the logistics and marketing of the event.
- They will also help foster a welcoming environment at the conference and will be responsible for recruiting those volunteers.

#### HYPAC Advisory Group

- The HYPAC Advisory Group shall consist of three or more members including at least one member of the ADHA Board of Trustees, each appointed to a one-year term. Consecutive terms are permitted. After appointments have been approved, members of the HYPAC committee will determine an individual to serve as treasurer and report to the board during the Fall Board of Trustees meeting. An ADHA staff member will serve as assistant treasurer. (BOT-20-00)

#### Constituent Advisory Committee

- This standing committee will help to ensure successful implementation of the charter agreements and serve in a support and advisory capacity to both state leaders and the ADHA Board of Trustees. Please see the [Guide to the Charter Agreements](#) for charge, composition and responsibilities.
