

## **ANCC 2022 Research Symposium: Call for Session Proposals**

The ANCC Research and Quality program invites clinical nurse scientists and other researchers, faculty, administrators, and students to submit a proposal for a presentation for the ANCC 2022 Research Symposium held as a pre-conference to the ANCC National Magnet Conference® and Pathway to Excellence Conference® in Philadelphia, PA on October 12, 2022.

The theme of this year's symposium is, bolstering nursing and interprofessional research capacity and addressing the many challenges faced in establishing and maintaining practice-based nursing research.

Proposal submission topics of interest include research programs, research program start-ups, evaluation strategies, research initiatives, or research-related activities. Submissions should focus on innovative thinking and a dynamic interactive experience with audience involvement.

### **Key topics and conference goals will be in alignment with priorities of ANCC's Research Council:**

- Disseminating a research agenda for practice-based research that aligns with recommendations in the consensus study report *The Future of Nursing 2020-2030: Charting a Path to Achieve Health Equity*
- Expand capacity to conduct multi-site, interprofessional research across diverse practice settings
- Role model and promote diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) in the planning and execution of practice-based research
- Expand knowledge, skills, and abilities for nursing research

### **After attending the symposium, participants will be able to:**

- Discover solutions to problems that occur in the practice setting
- Explore ways in which organizational resources impact research capacity
- Identify sources to obtain funding to grow research capacity

### **Sessions may be focused on the following topic areas:**

- Development of a successful research program/project
- Presentations from successful research programs
- Building a culture of research inquiry
- Advocating and supporting a research-friendly environment
- Engaging clinical nurses and patients in research
- Grant and proposal writing, and budgeting

**Special emphasis will focus on:**

- Nursing outcomes research and nurse well-being
- Strategies for DEI may include enhancing diversity in research subjects, research teams, reviewers, other stakeholders
- Research design and methodological approaches

**Submission Guidelines:**

Submissions may not exceed 250 words and must include:

- Title of Presentation
- Speaker(s) name, title, and credentials
- Short description of the presentation

**Submission Acceptances:**

Presenters will be notified of their acceptance via email no later than **May 15, 2022.**

All presenters are **required** to register for the pre-conference event and assume costs associated with registration, travel, and accommodations for the event. Presenter expenses *will not* be covered, and no honoraria are offered. If you wish to attend the ANCC National Magnet Conference® and Pathway to Excellence Conference® from October 13-15, 2022, additional registration fees will apply.

All presentations are reviewed by the Research Program team and the event nurse planners. Presenters will be responsible for obtaining all copyright permissions for use of materials in their presentation – photos, logos, cartoons, etc. – where required by law.

Continued Nurse Education (CNE) hours are awarded for session presentations. All presenters will be required to sign a Disclosure of Relevant Financial Relationships agreement and the Presenter Release Acknowledgement form, if accepted.
